To All Members of the PCRB:

Re: **POLICY ENTRY AND EDIT PACKAGE DISCONTINUATION**

The Compensation Data Exchange (CDX) has announced the discontinuation of the Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) on December 31, 2014 (see attached).

PCRB is in the development phase of work towards a product for use in the reporting of policy information in the absence of PEEP.

Note that WCPOLS files currently transferred via CDX to the PCRB will not be affected by the discontinuation of PEEP or the PCRB's development of a replacement application.

Future communications on the PCRB's PEEP replacement product will be forthcoming.

## **CDX Announcement**

**October 15, 2012**

TO: CDX PEEP Users

FROM: CDX Management

RE: PEEP – Policy Entry and Edit Package

Attention: CDX PEEP Users

CDX has decided that Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) will no longer be available after December 31, 2014, because the program is cost prohibitive to maintain. Each Data Collection Organization (DCO) will independently determine if they will build a replacement product. Some DCOs have already developed such a product. It is recommended that you contact individual DCOs as necessary with any questions, concerns, or to obtain additional information. Each DCO will advise the industry as it determines its course of action.

Please note that only PEEP is being discontinued. This will have no impact on other CDX products such as Bureau Entry and Edit Package (BEEP). Direct file transfer of WCPOLS files through CDX will also be unaffected.
