To All Members of the PCRB:

Re: **POLICY ENTRY AND EDIT PACKAGE DISCONTINUATION – SECOND NOTICE**

The Compensation Data Exchange (CDX) has issued a reminder about the discontinuation of the Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) on December 31, 2014 (see attached).

PCRB is in the development phase of work towards a product for use in the reporting of policy information in the absence of PEEP.

Note that WCPOLS files currently transferred via CDX to the PCRB will not be affected by the discontinuation of PEEP or the PCRB's development of a replacement application.

Future communications on the PCRB's PEEP replacement product will be forthcoming.

CDX Announcement

TO: CDX PEEP Users

RE: Reminder: PEEP – Policy Entry and Edit Package will be discontinued on December 31, 2014

This is a reminder that Policy Entry and Edit Package (PEEP) will no longer be available after December 31, 2014. Please also refer to a previous announcement that was sent out as a circular by the DCOs in October, 2012. Note that only PEEP is being discontinued. This will have no impact on other CDX products, and direct file transfer of WCPOLS files through CDX will also be unaffected.

Carriers must plan a course of action for creating WCPOLS data to send to each DCO well in advance of the discontinuation of the PEEP application. The PEEP database in CDX will also be discontinued, so carriers should archive any policy data that they want to retain from the database prior to December 31, 2014. A guide to archiving PEEP data is in the PEEP User Guide, which is available from the left-hand menu of CDX on the log-in page.

Please watch for announcements regarding WCPOLS creation alternatives being developed by individual DCOs.
